It is essential for music majors to consult a full time music faculty to make sure they enroll in the appropriate music courses. All students should also consult the MJC course catalog and the counseling staff to make sure they enroll in the proper general education courses. Always consult with the admissions and music departments of the academic institution you wish to transfer to at least 2 years ahead of time.
