

MJC's Bachelor's Degree Program in Respiratory Care is now 100% online!

Modesto Junior College is pleased to announce that our Bachelor's Degree Program in Respiratory Care is now completely online. It is a 40-unit, accelerated 15-month program offered in an eight-week format.

This program is designed for working professionals who have:

- Completed an associate's degree
- Graduated from a CoARC accredited respiratory care program
- Obtained a Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) credential
- Obtained a valid California Respiratory Care Practitioner (RCP) license, and
- Completed the 39 required CSU-GE Transfer Pattern units (CSU-GE Certification).

Program costs are estimated at \$5,200 in course fees, plus \$1,350 for textbooks and materials fees.

Bachelor's prepared respiratory therapists have a greater ability to advance into leadership, education, and case management roles related to patient care in the field of respiratory care. Students will acquire advanced knowledge and skills in neonatal, pediatric, and adult critical respiratory care; management in respiratory care settings, teaching and research.

A new cohort of students is accepted annually to begin the program in August.
