



**A RESOLUTION TO:** Radically hold Chancellor Henry Yong and the 7 Board of Trustees accountable and demand full transparency for all terminations, leaves, and investigations on employees whose contractual payouts have had a profound impact on students, the morale at Modesto Junior College, and results in the expenditure of public funds in a reckless and wasteful manner; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Trustees and Chancellor Dr. Henry Yong are being obscure with the public's funds; and

**WHEREAS,** funds spent by the 7 Board of Trustees and Chancellor Dr. Henry Yong for undisclosed investigations could instead be allocated to directly benefit students through better investment in facilities, employment of additional professors, or expansion of student programs and services; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Trustees and the Chancellor refuse to disclose information to the responding parties and the public that they serve concerning contractual terminations and internal investigations which violates Board Policy 3-8020; and

**WHEREAS,** the morale of the Modesto Junior College community (students, staff, faculty, administration) continues to be negatively impacted and demeaned; and

**NOTING,** The Chancellor highly praised the efforts made by Dr. Santanu Bandyopadhyay months before terminating his contract because of "personnel", which stands as an action of the continuous contradictions from the YCCD and its promise of prioritizing the best interest of the college in exchange for the interests of themselves; and

**STRESSING,** that Chancellor Dr. Henry Yong's refusal to sign longer contracts in fear of "higher buyouts" apparently signals incompetence and unwillingness to invest in a long-term MJC presidency; and

**EMPHASIZING,** this incompetence and lack of confidence cultivates suspicion and concern among YCCD employees, students, and the community at large; and

**NOTING WITH DEEP CONCERN,** the Chancellor and the Board of Trustees have given Modesto Junior College a reputation of incompetence which frankly and collectively leads to inconfidence in the institution amongst the student body at Modesto Junior College; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** The Associated Students of Modesto Junior College demands that Chancellor Henry Yong and the 7 Board of Trustees shall fully disclose all information and justifications for decisions made by the District, as lack of transparency continues to negatively impact thousands of students, faculty, staff, and instructors; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** The Associated Students of MJC urges the Board of Trustees and The Chancellor to be mindful of the expenditure of funds and prioritize the best interest of Modesto Junior College.
